<p>March 26, 2008 (E-90)</p>	<p><u>NOTICE OF ELECTION:</u> The Registrar of Voters must publish once in a newspaper of general circulation the Notice of Election. The notice shall contain the date of the election; the offices for which candidates may be nominated; the qualifications for each office; and when and where nomination papers may be obtained. The Registrar of Voters shall deliver a copy of the published notice to the school district secretary, who shall post it. §§ 12112, 12113, Ed. §§ 5361, 5363</p>
<p>March 26, 2008 through April 10, 2008 (E-90 -- 75)</p>	<p><u>NOMINATION PERIOD:</u> Declaration of Candidacy forms may be obtained from and must be filed with the Registrar of Voters office from March 26, 2008 through April 10, 2008, 5:00 p.m. §§ 8020, 8100, 10603, 11381</p>
<p>March 26, 2008 through April 10, 2008 (E-90 -- 75)</p>	<p><u>CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS:</u> Each candidate may prepare a statement on a form provided by the Registrar of Voters. The statement may contain no more than 200 words. The statement must be filed at the same time the Declaration of Candidacy is filed. The statement may be withdrawn, <u>but not changed</u>, during the nomination period and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period. A candidate statement may not be changed. §§ 11381(b), 13307</p> <p>The Registrar of Voters will estimate the total cost of printing and handling of the candidates' statements and will require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance his/her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his/her statement included in the voter's pamphlet. This amount must be paid at the time the candidate's statement is filed. If there is an underpayment, the candidate shall be required to pay the balance of the cost incurred. Overpayments will be refunded within 30 days of the election. § 13307</p> <p>The candidate's statement is confidential until after the expiration of the filing period. Copies of all candidates' statements will be available for public inspection at the Registrar of Voters office and on the Registrar of Voters website for 10 calendar days prior to being submitted for printing. §§ 13311, 13313</p>

<p>May 26, 2008* (E-29)</p>	<p><u>LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION AND STILL BE MAILED A SAMPLE BALLOT PAMPHLET:</u> Voters registering after May 26, 2008* will NOT be mailed a county sample ballot pamphlet. §§ 9094, 13303</p>
<p>May 26, 2008* through June 17, 2008 (E-29 -- 7)</p>	<p><u>VOTE-BY-MAIL VOTING:</u> Applications for vote-by-mail ballots available during this period from the Registrar of Voters office. Applications must be received by the Registrar of Voters office by June 17, 2008, 5:00 p.m. §§ 3001, 3003, 3206</p>
<p>June 8, 2008 through June 23, 2008 (E-16 - 1)</p>	<p><u>LATE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION REPORTING PERIOD:</u> Contributions received of \$1,000 or more per source must be reported within 24 hours during this period. Gov't § 84203</p>
<p>June 9, 2008 (E-15)</p>	<p><u>LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THE SPECIAL RECALL ELECTION:</u> Closing date of registration for this election. §§ 2102, 2107</p>
<p>June 10, 2008 (E-14)</p>	<p><u>DEADLINE FOR WRITE-IN CANDIDATES TO FILE:</u> Last day for a write-in candidate to file a statement of write-in candidacy and a Declaration of Candidacy with the Registrar of Voters office by 5:00 p.m. § 8601</p>
<p>June 12, 2008 (E-12)</p>	<p><u>SECOND PRE-ELECTION CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS DUE:</u> The last day to file campaign disclosure statements for candidates and committees covering the period May 11, 2008 through June 7, 2008. Gov't §§ 84200.5, 84200.7</p>
<p>June 18, 2008 through June 24, 2008 (E-6 - 0)</p>	<p><u>VOTE-BY-MAIL VOTING – LATE CONDITIONS:</u> During this period, vote-by-mail ballots are available when conditions prevent voting at a polling place. Written application signed under penalty of perjury is required unless the vote-by-mail voter's ballot is voted in the Registrar of Voters office. § 3021</p>
<p>June 24, 2008 (E-0)</p>	<p><u>ELECTION DAY:</u> Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Ballots will be centrally counted at the Registrar of Voters office. §§ 14212, 15260</p>

<p>June 24, 2008 (E-0)</p>	<p><u>VOTE-BY-MAIL VOTER BALLOTS RETURNED:</u> Deadline for the Registrar of Voters office to receive vote-by-mail ballots by mail or in person is June 24, 2008, 8:00 p.m. A voter may deliver his/her vote-by-mail ballot in person to the Registrar of Voters office or to any polling place in the county by the close of the polls on Election Day. §§ 3017, 3020</p>
<p>June 24, 2008 (E-0)</p>	<p><u>SEMI-OFFICIAL CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS:</u> Beginning at 8:00 p.m. and continuing until completed, the Registrar of Voters will conduct the semi-official canvass of votes and report totals to the Secretary of State. §§ 15150, 15151</p>
<p>June 25, 2008 (E+1)</p>	<p><u>COMMENCE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS:</u> The Registrar of Voters will commence the official canvass of votes. §§ 10547, 15301</p>
<p>July 22, 2008 (E+28)</p>	<p><u>COMPLETE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF ELECTION RETURNS AND CERTIFY RESULTS BY THIS DATE:</u> The Registrar of Voters will certify the results of the election and prepare a statement of the results. § 15372</p>
<p>After certification of election</p>	<p><u>CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION:</u> Approximately on this date, the elections official shall make and deliver to each person elected or nominated, a certificate of election or nomination, signed by the elections official. § 15401</p> <p><u>DATE OF TAKING OFFICE:</u> If at a recall election an officer is recalled, the candidate receiving the highest number of votes for the office shall be declared elected for the unexpired term of the recalled officer. § 11385</p> <p>If the candidate who received the highest number of votes fails to qualify within 10 days after receiving his/her certificate of election, the office to which he/she was elected shall be vacant, and shall be filled according to law. § 11386</p>
<p>July 31, 2008 (E+37)</p>	<p><u>SEMI-ANNUAL CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS DUE:</u> Last day to file semi-annual campaign disclosure statements for all candidates and committees for the period June 8, 2008 through June 30, 2008. Gov't §§ 84200, 84218</p>
