

## ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF MEASURE T

**MAKE LA HABRA SAFER** – improve OUR services -- **VOTE YES on T.**  
Consider this:

There are nearly 600 gang members and associates, 500 parolees and 50 registered sex offenders living in La Habra.

Police are so busy responding to the community's 9-1-1 calls, they have little time to patrol or conduct community policing in our City.

The State faces a multi-Billion Dollar deficit. The Governor has already proposed funding cuts that threaten the quality of our essential City services. We need more money to protect our services – without additional revenue, our City will have no choice but to cut services over the next several years.

**YES on T** funds more police officers so we can prevent crime BEFORE it happens.

**YES on T** funds more school police officers, anti-gang and anti-drug prevention programs, and the after-school programs that keep our kids off the streets and out of trouble.

Prescription medicine and food purchased as groceries, are exempt from Measure T.

**YES on T** is fiscally responsible and will **EXPIRE IN 20 YEARS**. It requires independent annual audits available for public review.
