If the full amount of time allowed under the Elections Code is used, the measure could not be placed on the June 3, 2008 Statewide Direct Primary Election ballot. All section references are to the California Elections Code.

NOTE: During this 180-day period and prior to circulation, proponents must publish the Notice of Intention and County Counsel’s Ballot Title and Summary in a newspaper of general circulation published in the county. Proof of publication must be provided to the Registrar of Voters prior to circulation. However, the clock begins on the 180 days as soon as the proponents receive the Ballot Title and Summary from Registrar of Voters. §9105(b), §9110, §9116, §9118</p> <p>Last day for Registrar of Voters to verify petition signatures in order to place on ballot. §9114</p> <p>Anticipated date of Registrar of Voter’s submission of certification of sufficiency of an initiative petition to Board of Supervisors (BOS). Options for BOS at that meeting include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order submission of the measure to the voters at the June 3, 2008 Statewide Direct Primary Election. • Request various reports on the effect of proposed initiative(s). <p>March 17, 2008 (E-78)</p>	<p>Deadline for submittal of Rebuttal Arguments to be filed with Registrar of Voters. § 9167</p>
<p>March 18, 2008 through March 27, 2008 (E-77 – 68)</p>	<p>Public Review period for Rebuttal Arguments begins on March 18, 2008 and closes March 27, 2008. The Rebuttal Arguments will be posted on the Registrar of Voters website and available at the Registrar of Voters office on Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Only Rebuttal Arguments are subject to legal action during this public review period. § 9190</p>
<p>April 24, 2008 (E-40)</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters begins sample ballot mailing approximately on this date. Mailing completed no later than May 24, 2008. §13300</p>
<p>May 5, 2008 (E-29)</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters begins mailing vote-by-mail ballots. § 3001</p>
<p>May 24, 2008 (E-10)</p>	<p>Sample ballot mailing ends. §13300</p>
<p>May 19, 2008 (E-15)</p>	<p>Last day to register for June 3, 2008 Statewide Direct Primary Election. § 2102</p>
