

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the Buena Park School District that in accordance with the provisions of the Education Code and the Government Code of the State of California, an election will be consolidated with the June 8, 2010 Statewide Direct Primary Election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District the proposition summarized as follows:

“To prevent deep cuts in Buena Park elementary and middle school educational programs; retain qualified, experienced teachers; keep school libraries open; and maintain school campuses, nurses/health and counseling services, music and physical education programs; shall Buena Park School District levy an annual tax of \$0.0375 per square foot of building space per each assessor’s parcel, for 4 years only, with independent oversight, an exemption for senior citizens, and all funds benefiting neighborhood K-8 schools?”

Notice is further given that the Registrar of Voters has determined that the last day and time for filing arguments for or against this parcel tax measure is March 22, 2010, 5:00 p.m., at the Registrar of Voters office, 1300-C South Grand Avenue, Santa Ana. No arguments shall exceed 300 words in length. No more than 5 signatures shall appear with any argument for or against the measure.
