

**EMERGENCY VOTING APPLICATION
FOR THE JUNE 7, 2011
CITY OF SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
(Elections Code Section §3021)**

Emergency ballots are issued in the last six days prior to an election and on Election Day. These ballots cannot be issued by mail. To obtain an emergency ballot, a voter may request in a written statement, signed under penalty of perjury, that a ballot be delivered to him/her. The emergency ballot may be given by the Registrar of Voters office to any authorized representative of the voter who presents this written statement. The authorized person is not limited to a relative of the voter. The ballot must be returned to the Registrar of Voters office or to any polling place in Orange County by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 1300 South Grand Avenue, Building C, Santa Ana, CA 92705; telephone number (714) 567-7600.
