

**EMERGENCY VOTING APPLICATION  
FOR THE JANUARY 12, 2010  
72<sup>ND</sup> ASSEMBLY DISTRICT SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION  
(Elections Code Section §3021)**

Vote-by-Mail Ballots issued in the last 6 days prior to an election and on Election Day are called Emergency Vote-by-Mail ballots. These ballots cannot be issued by mail. To obtain an Emergency Vote-by-Mail ballot, a voter may request in a written statement, signed under penalty of perjury, that a ballot be delivered to him/her. This Emergency Vote-by-Mail ballot may be delivered by the Registrar of Voters office to any authorized representative of the voter who presents this written statement. An authorized representative is not limited to a relative of the voter. The ballot must be returned to the Registrar of Voters office or to any polling place in Orange County by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. **This written statement is not required if the Vote-by-Mail ballot is voted in the office of the Registrar of Voters.** The Registrar of Voters office is located at 1300 South Grand Avenue, Building C, Santa Ana, CA 92705; telephone number (714) 567-7600.
