

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON CITY OF YORBA LINDA SPECIAL RECALL ELECTION

There are two questions on the City of Yorba Linda Special Recall Election ballot for each recall. Refer to the ballot images below.

FIRST QUESTION:

Whether or not the incumbent City Council Member shall be recalled:

Shall Thomas H. Lindsey be recalled (removed) from the office of City Council Member?

- Yes
 No

Shall Craig Young be recalled (removed) from the office of City Council Member?

- Yes
 No

A “**Yes**” vote means the voter wants the incumbent City Council Member recalled (removed) from office.

A “**No**” vote means that the voter wants the incumbent City Council Member to remain in office.

SECOND QUESTION:

The second question on the ballot considers those candidates who are campaigning to replace the incumbent City Council Member if he is recalled. A voter may vote for one of those candidates who are listed on the ballot or may write-in the name of a qualified write-in candidate.

Candidates to succeed Thomas H. Lindsey as City Council Member if he is recalled, for the duration of his term ending December 2, 2014.

Vote for One

 Jeffrey N. Decker

Candidates to succeed Craig Young as City Council Member if he is recalled, for the duration of his term ending December 6, 2016.

Vote for One

- Nancy Rikel
 J. Minton Brown Jr.

VOTES CAST BY THE VOTER:

A voter may lawfully cast votes on both questions or cast a vote only on either of the two questions. A voter DOES NOT need to cast a vote for both questions to ensure that the vote he/she did cast on only one question will be counted.

RESULTS OF THE ELECTION:

If more voters mark “Yes” than “No” on the first question, the incumbent City Council Member will be recalled (removed) from office.

If more voters mark “No” than “Yes” on the first question, the incumbent City Council Member will remain in office.

If the incumbent City Council Member is recalled (removed), the candidate who receives the most votes in the second question will be elected as the new City Council Member for the duration of the term. That person can be sworn-in as the City Council Member once the results of the election are certified.
