

ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF MEASURE E

The Brea Olinda Unified School District has always provided a high quality education, and continues to receive State and National recognition. To date, the District has done a good job of constructing and maintaining schools with minimal local funding. The District's tax rate for school facility improvements has historically been less than the amount promised to voters during the prior election.

However, efficiently maintaining our school is no longer enough. We must now invest in transforming our schools so that our students will have 21st century classrooms, technology and vocational educational facilities that will best prepare them for college or enable them to successfully compete for jobs.

Measure "E" makes financial sense.
