1. Mark your ballot

• Follow the directions on the ballot.

2. Seal your envelope

- Check that you have the return envelope with your name on it.
- Put your ballot into the envelope.
- Seal the envelope.

3. Sign the envelope

- Date and sign your name on the back of the envelope in ink.
- Print your name and voter registration address.

4. Options for returning your ballot

- Mail your ballot in the enclosed postage paid envelope.
- Drop off your ballot at any polling place on Election Day.
- Drop off your ballot at a Pop-Up Voting Service Center (for locations and hours, visit ocvote.com/early).

Important additional info!

- If you make a mistake call 714-567-7600 before Election Day.
- Your ballot must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than 3 days after Election Day.
- If you choose to vote in person, be sure to bring your vote-by-mail ballot with you to avoid additional check-in requirements.
