



# Mark, seal, and sign your envelope

## 1. Mark your ballot

- Follow the directions on the ballot.

## 2. Seal your envelope

- Check that you have the return envelope with your name on it.
- Put your ballot into the envelope.
- Seal the envelope.

## 3. Sign the envelope

- Date and sign your name on the back of the envelope in ink.
- Print your name and **Orange County Residence Address, as it appears on your registration affidavit.**

## 4. Options for returning your ballot

### BY MAIL

- Place your voted ballot in an envelope.
- Cut the ID Envelope Image along the black lines and glue or tape it to the envelope containing the voted ballot.
- If you desire, you may place this ID envelope in a larger envelope for mailing.
- Your ballot must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than 3 days after the Election Day.
- You may mail your ballot to: 1300 S. Grand Avenue, Building C, Santa Ana, CA 92705 or P.O. Box 11298, Santa Ana, CA 92711.

### BY FAX

- Complete the ID Envelope and Oath of Voter form.
- Fax your ballot, Oath of Voter form and ID Envelope to (714) 567-5100.
- Our office cannot accept your faxed ballot without the Oath of Voter form and the ID Envelope. Your faxed ballot must be received by 8:00 p.m. Election Day, March 12, 2019.

## Important additional info!

- **Ballots received by email will not be accepted.**
- **Please be sure to allow for sufficient time to either fax or mail your ballot back to our office.**
