Ex-Parte Application and Opposition are read and considered.

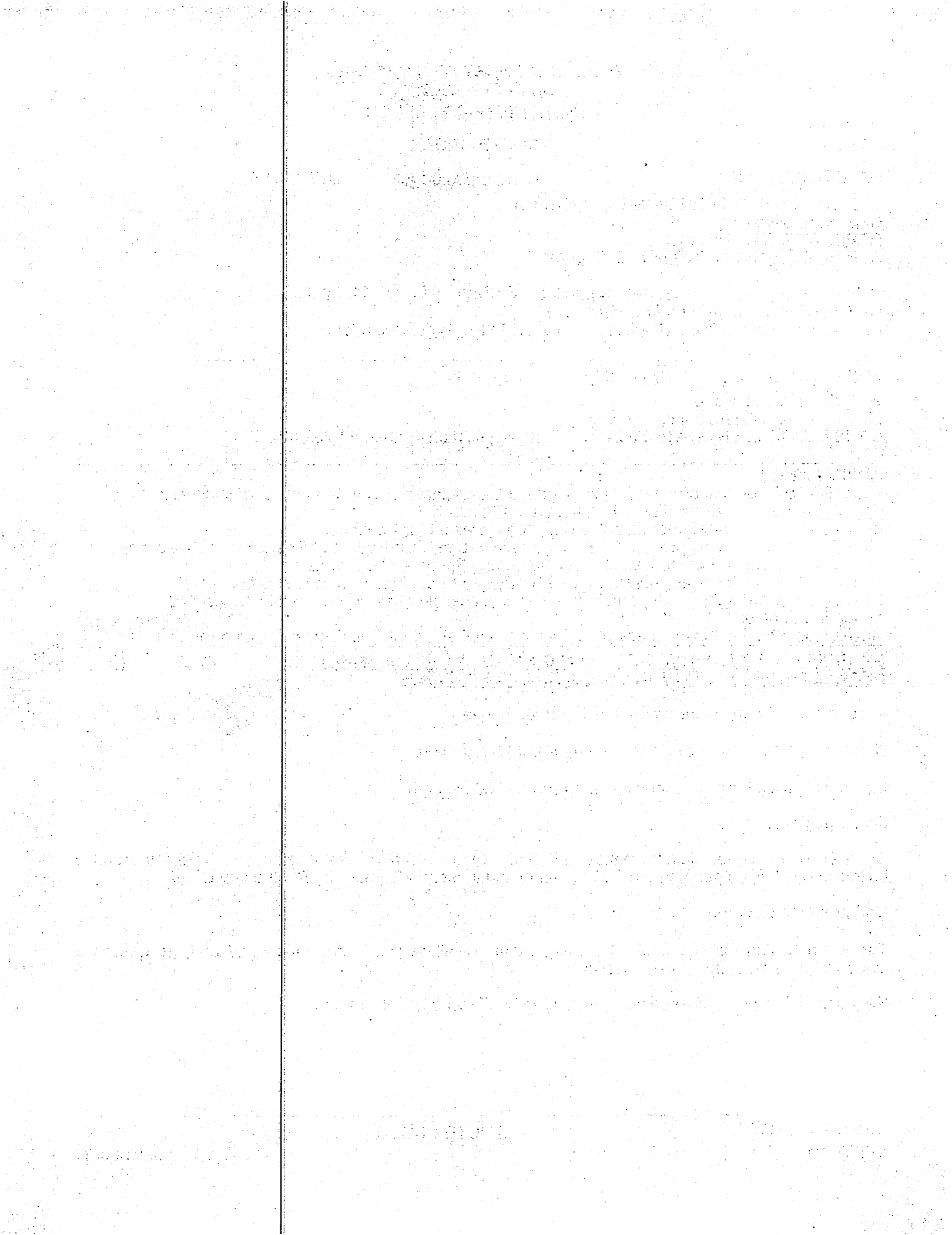
Oral arguments heard.
